

**RESOLUTION NO. 70-24**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MEDINA, IN MEDINA COUNTY, COMMONWEALTH OF OHIO, SUPPORTING THE OHIO COMMISSION FOR THE UNITED STATES SEMIQUINCENTENNIAL (AMERICA250-OH).**

**WHEREAS:** The Ohio legislature and the Governor created AMERICA250-OH in 2018 to plan, encourage, develop and coordinate the commemoration of the 250<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the United States and Ohio’s integral role in that event and the role of its people on the nation’s past, present and future; and

**WHEREAS:** By adoption of AMERICA250-OH Resolution we hope to educate, preserve, innovate, and celebrate.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MEDINA, OHIO:**

**SEC. 1:** That the City of Medina hereby endorses AMERICA250-OH and their mission to educate, preserve, innovate and celebrate EVERY Ohioan in EVERY county.

**SEC. 2:** That a copy of this resolution be sent to the City of Medina Municipal legislative delegation and AMERICA250-OH Commission.

**SEC. 3:** That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect at the earliest period allowed by law.
