

ORDINANCE NO. 97-19

AN ORDINANCE INCREASING THE EXPENDITURE TO OHIO REGIONAL DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION FOR THE SOFT COSTS RELATED TO THE IMPLEMENTATION AND ADMINISTRATION OF THE PY18 COMMUNITY HOUSING IMPACT AND PRESERVATION PROGRAM (CHIP) GRANT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS: The soft costs for the grant are estimated and it has been indicated that they have increased in the amount of \$101,368.00, making the total for soft costs \$170,068.00; and

WHEREAS: The City is respectfully requesting City Council increase Purchase Order No. 2019000513 to cover the additional costs.

NOW, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MEDINA, OHIO:

SEC. 1: That the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to increase the expenditure to Ohio Regional Development Corporation for the soft costs related to the implementation and administration of the PY18 Community Housing Impact and Preservation Program (CHIP) Grant as follows:

Line 006 – PY18 CHIP Program – 138-0458-52215 – Activity AC-18-03	<u>\$ 3,200.00</u>
	\$101,368.00

SEC. 2: That in accordance with Ohio Revised Code §5705.41(D), at the time that the contract or order was made and at the time of execution of the Finance Director’s certificate, sufficient funds were available or in the process of collection, to the credit of a proper fund, properly appropriated and free from any previous encumbrance.

SEC. 3: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law.

SEC. 4: That this Ordinance shall be considered an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and for the further reason the grant must be paid immediately; wherefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and signature by the Mayor.
