ORDINANCE NO. 32-20

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ADVERTISE FOR COMPETITIVE BIDS AND TO AWARD A CONTRACT TO THE SUCCESSFUL BIDDER FOR THE 2020 CONCRETE STREET REPAIR PROGRAM.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MEDINA, OHIO:

- SEC. 1: That the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to advertise for competitive bids and to award a contract to the successful bidder for the 2020 Concrete Street Repair Program in accordance with specifications on file in the office of the Mayor.
- SEC. 2: That the estimated cost of the contract, in the amount of \$500,000, is available as follows: \$475,000 in Account No. 108-0610-54411 and \$25,000 in Account No. 513-0533-54414.
- SEC. 3: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law.
- **SEC. 4:** That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect at the earliest period allowed by law.
