A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SUBMIT A GRANT APPLICATION WITH THE OHIO ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY (OEPA) FOR THE PURPOSE OF PURCHASING A NEW FRONT LOAD PACKER TRUCK TO BE USED IN THE COLLECTION OF RECYCLABLE MATERIALS.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MEDINA, OHIO:

- SEC. 1: That the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to submit a grant application with the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (OEPA) for the purpose of funding \$100,000 toward purchasing a new front load Packer Truck to be used in the collection of recyclable materials.
- **SEC. 2:** That if the Grant is awarded to the City, the Mayor is authorized to accept the grant and complete all documentation necessary for the implementation and administration of the grant.
- **SEC. 3:** If the Grant is successful, the City will be responsible for \$186,000.00 toward the purchase of this vehicle, and the funds will be available in Account No. 514-0543-54417.
- SEC. 3: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law.
- SEC. 4: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect at the earliest period allowed by law.
