ORDINANCE NO. 17-21

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF \$60,000 TO SIGNAL SERVICE COMPANY FOR THE STREET DEPARTMENT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MEDINA, OHIO:

- SEC. 1: That the expenditure of \$60,000.00 is hereby authorized to Signal Service Company for the emergency repairs and maintenance to the City Traffic system.
- SEC. 2: That the funds to cover this expenditure in the amount of \$60,000.00 are available in Account No. 102-0145-53321.
- SEC. 3: That in accordance with Ohio Revised Code §5705.41(D), at the time that the contract or order was made and at the time of execution of the Finance Director's certificate, sufficient funds were available or in the process of collection, to the credit of a proper fund, properly appropriated and free from any previous encumbrance.
- SEC. 4: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law.
- SEC. 5: That this Ordinance shall be considered in full force and effect at the earliest period allowed by law.
