

ORDINANCE NO. 80-21

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE INCREASE OF THE EXPENDITURE TO BAKER DUBLIKAR BECK WILEY & MATTHEWS TO \$55,000 FOR THE LAW DEPARTMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS: The Law Director has requested to increase Purchase Order #2021000090 from \$15,000.00 to \$55,000.00, which requires the Council's approval; and

NOW, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MEDINA, OHIO:

SEC. 1: That the increase to Purchase Order #2021000090 from \$15,000 to \$55,000 is hereby authorized for the Law Department.

SEC. 2: That the funds to cover this expenditure are available in Account No. 001-0704-52225.

SEC. 3: That in accordance with Ohio Revised Code §5705.41(D), at the time that the contract or order was made and at the time of execution of the Finance Director's certificate, sufficient funds were available or in the process of collection, to the credit of a proper fund, properly appropriated and free from any previous encumbrance.

SEC. 4: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law.

SEC. 5: That this Ordinance shall be considered an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and for the further reason services have been performed; wherefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and signature by the Mayor.
