A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ACCEPT AN ARPA (AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT) GRANT FROM THE FEDERAL AVIATION ADMINISTRATION (FAA) TO BE USED FOR VARIOUS PURPOSES AT THE MEDINA MUNICIPAL AIRPORT.

WHEREAS: The City of Medina has applied for and has been awarded funding from the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) for a Grant through the ARPA (American Rescue Plan Act) to be used for various purposed at the Medina Municipal Airport.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MEDINA, OHIO:

- SEC. 1: That the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to accept \$32,000 in grant funds from the Federal Aviation Administration for funding through the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA), Grant #3-39-0053-019-2022, to be used for costs related to operations, personnel, cleaning, sanitization, janitorial services, combatting the spread of pathogens at the airport, and debt service payments at the Medina Municipal Airport.
- SEC. 2: That the Mayor is hereby authorized to accept the grant and complete all documentation necessary for the implementation and administration of the grants.
- SEC. 3: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law.
- **SEC. 4:** That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect at the earliest period allowed by law.
