ORDINANCE NO. 39-22

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SOLICIT REQUEST FOR QUALIFICATIONS (RFQ'S)/REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS (RFP'S) FOR CONSULTANT SERVICES FOR THE PY22 CITY OF MEDINA COMMUNITY HOUSING IMPACT AND PRESERVATION PROGRAM (CHIP) AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) PROGRAM APPLICATIONS INCLUDING ADMINISTRATION AND IMPLEMENTATION, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MEDINA, OHIO:

- That the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to solicit Request for Qualifications (RFQ's)/Request for Proposals (RFP's) for consultant services for the PY22 City of Medina Community Housing Impact and Preservation Program (CHIP) and Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program applications, including administration and implementation, and to award the RFQ/RFP to the successful bidder.
- **SEC. 2:** That the City intends to make application in partnership with the City of Brunswick.
- SEC. 3: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law.
- SEC. 4: That this Ordinance shall be considered an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and for the further reason that two pre-planning meetings are required and the application deadline is May 20, 2022; wherefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and signature by the Mayor.
