ORDINANCE NO. 115-22

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 35-22, PASSED FEBRUARY 28, 2022 RELATIVE TO THE PURCHASE AGREEMENT FOR THE PROPERTY LOCATED AT 368 FOUNDRY STREET, MEDINA, OHIO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

- **WHEREAS:** Ordinance No. 35-22, passed February 28, 2022, authorized the Mayor to execute a Purchase Agreement for the property located at 368 Foundry Street for a cost of \$71,000.00; and
- **WHEREAS:** The Settlement for the property came in at \$71,206.71.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MEDINA, OHIO:

- SEC. 1: That Ordinance No. 35-22, passed February 28, 2022, is hereby amended to state that the funds to cover this purchase are in the amount of \$71,206.71 are available in Account No. 171-0301-54411.
- SEC. 3: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law.
- SEC. 4: That this Ordinance shall be considered an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and for the further reason the title agency needs the funds before May 25, 2022; wherefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and signature by the Mayor.
