ORDINANCE NO. 125-22

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 60-22, PASSED MARCH 28, 2022, RELATIVE TO THE AGREEMENT WITH WICHERT INSURANCE FOR THE CITY'S PROPERTY AND GENERAL LIABILITY INSURANCE.

- WHEREAS: Ordinance No. 60-22, passed March 28, 2022, authorized an Agreement with Wichert Insurance for the City's Property and General Liability Insurance for the period of April 1, 2022 through March 31, 2023 at a cost of \$192,558.00; and
- **WHEREAS:** An additional cost of \$2,163.00 has to be added to the contract to add liability insurance for two additional Unmanned Aircraft (drones).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MEDINA, OHIO:

- **SEC. 1:** That Ordinance No. 60-22, passed March 28, 2022, is hereby amended to read that the funds to cover this expenditure in the estimated amount of not to exceed \$194,721.00 (an increase of \$2,163.00) are available in each appropriate budget.
- **SEC. 3:** That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law.
- **SEC. 4:** That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect at the earliest period allowed by law.
