A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO APPLY FOR AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT (ARPA) FUNDING FOR A FIRST RESPONDER WELLNESS, RECRUITMENT, RETENTION & RESILIENCY GRANT FOR THE CITY OF MEDINA POLICE DEPARTMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MEDINA, OHIO:

- SEC. 1: That the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to apply for American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) Funding with the Ohio Emergency Management Agency for a First Responder Wellness, Recruitment, Retention & Resiliency Grant for the Medina City Police Department.
- **SEC. 2:** That if the Grant is awarded to the City of Medina Police Department, the Mayor is authorized to accept the grant and execute any and all documentation associated with said grant.
- SEC. 3: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law.
- SEC. 4: That this Resolution shall be considered an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and for the further reason the grant was due on June 17, 2022; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and signature by the Mayor.
