RESOLUTION NO. 144-22

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE APPLICATION AND ACCEPT REIMBURSEMENTS FROM THE PATRICK LEAHY BULLETPROOF BJA GRANT FOR THE PURCHASE OF BULLETPROOF VESTS FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MEDINA, OHIO:

- SEC. 1: That the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to file an application and accept reimbursements from the Patrick Leahy Bulletproof BJA Grant for the purchase of four (4) Bulletproof Vests for the Police Department.
- SEC. 2: That if the Grant is awarded to the City, the Mayor is authorized to accept the grant and enter into an agreement with the Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA) for the implementation and administration of the grant.
- SEC. 3: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law.
- SEC. 4: That this Resolution shall be considered an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and for the further reason the grant was due at the end of June, 2022; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and signature by the Mayor.
