Storm Damage and Tree Limb Debris Removal Notification

Two ways The City of Medina will pick up storm damage:

1. The City of Medina will only pick up properly prepared tree limbs and debris. The debris should be tied correctly with rope or twine into nice, neat two feet by four feet long bundles. These bundles will be picked up on your normal trash pick up day.



2. When there is a storm within the City, the Forestry Department will remove a large limb or two with a wood chipper as long as the branch is greater than three inches in diameter. The branch should be left whole and placed in the tree lawn with the butt following the direction of traffic. However, they will not chip branches that can be bundled or branches that fill up most of the tree lawn. If you have a lot of branches it would be best to hire a tree service.



The City of Medina will pick up properly prepared brush for up to two weeks after a storm.
