- 2. <u>24-001-1/8 2024 Tax Advance Request</u>

Mr. Dirham stated this is an annual thing and they are required to request these advances. Mr. Shields moved to approve, seconded by Mr. Simpson. Motion passed 6-0.

3. <u>24-002-1/8 – Repeal Ord. 207-23 / Increase P.O. 2023-1706 Wise Waterproofing</u> Mr. Dutton stated this was a P.O. to increase but they inadvertently transposed some numbers with the account numbers and vendor. Emergency is needed to clean up the account number. Mr. Shields moved to approve with the emergency clause, seconded by Mr. Simpson. Motion passed 6-0.

4. <u>24-003-1/8 – Expenditure Over \$20,000 – Akron Uniforms – Police Dept</u>. Chief Kinney stated this an expenditure for Akron Uniform. Mr. Shields moved to approve, seconded by Mr. Simpson. Motion passed 6-0.

5. <u>24-004-1/8 – Expenditure Over \$20,000 – Huntington Bank – Police Dept</u>. Chief Kinney stated this is a blanket P.O. for their Huntington credit card. Mr. Shields moved to approve, seconded by Mr. Simpson. Motion passed 6-0.

6. <u>24-005-1/8 – Expenditure Over \$20,000 – Fire Safety Services – Fire Dept.</u> Chief Walters stated this is an annual blanket for firefighter PPE and firefighting equipment. Mr. Shields moved to approve, seconded by Mr. Simpson. Motion passed 6-0.

7. <u>24-006-1/8 – Expenditure Over \$20,000 – Armstrong Cable – IT Dept</u>. Sergeant Zaremba stated this is a super blanket purchase order for internet services throughout the entire city as well as cable. Mr. Shields moved to approve, seconded by Mr. Simpson. Motion passed 6-0.

8. <u>24-007-1/8 – Expenditure Over \$20,000 – Technology Engineering – IT Dept.</u> Sergeant Zaremba stated this is for our entire city's phone system VOIT phone system. Mr. Shields moved to approve, seconded by Mr. Simpson. Motion passed 6-0.

9. <u>24-008-1/8 – Adopt Multi-Use Path Plan</u>

Ryan Smalley from the vision group gave an overview of the multi-use plan. Mr. Shields moved to approve, seconded by Mr. Simpson. Motion passed 6-0.

10. <u>24-009-1/8 – Architect Design Services Agreement – Medina Municipal Court</u>

Patrick Patton stated received a total of 5 qualification statements and they were reviewed over several meetings. The committee voted unanimously to recommend to hire Brandstetter Carroll for this work and the design fee is \$720,000.00.

Mr. Coyne stated they had previously discussed that the Special Project Fund would be used for the construction and then for half the project whatever the cost would be, and then the next half would be slit 50/50 between the city and the Special Project Fund using funds generated over the years of the special project fee that's charged to help pay for that. We will have to revisit that second half.

Mr. Shields moved to approve, seconded by Mr. Simpson. Motion passed 6-0.

11. <u>24-010-1/8 – Capital Improvement Purchase Order – MCRC</u>

Jansen stated that this is their annual request for the balance of the Capital Fund for the purchase order to pay the schools. There are some substantial projects outlined particularly in the summer of 2025. Mr. Shields will abstain since it involves his employer. Mr. Simpson moved to approve, seconded by Mr. Rose. Motion passed 5-1. Jim Shields abstained.
