

**RESOLUTION NO. 132-24**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MEDINA POLICE DEPARTMENT TO APPLY FOR THE 2024 STATE VIOLENT CRIME GRANT AND TO ACCEPT THE GRANT IF IT IS AWARDED.**

**WHEREAS:** The Medina Police Department intends to apply for the 2024 State Violent Crime Grant under the OCJS for license plate readers for the amount of \$30,000 to cover the cost of the FLOCK camera system for 2025.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MEDINA, OHIO:**

**SEC. 1:** That the Police Department is hereby authorized to apply for, and accept if awarded, a 2024 State Violent Crime Grant in the amount of \$30,000.

**SEC. 2:** That if the Grant is awarded, the Mayor is hereby authorized to accept the Grant and complete all documentation for the implementation and administration of the Grant.

**SEC. 3:** That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law.

**SEC. 4:** That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect at the earliest period allowed by law.
