

RESOLUTION NO. 3-20

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE COUNTY AUDITOR TO MAKE TAX ADVANCES DURING THE YEAR 2020 PURSUANT TO OHIO REVISED CODE SECTION 321.34, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MEDINA, OHIO:

- SEC. 1:** That the County Auditor is hereby requested to draw and the County Treasurer to pay on such draft, to the Director of Finance of the City of Medina, Ohio such money as may be in the county treasury from time to time during the year 2020, to the account of the City of Medina, Ohio and lawfully applicable to the purpose of the current fiscal year in which such request is made. Such payments are to be made from time to time as the Director of Finance may request.
- SEC. 2:** That the Clerk of Council is hereby directed to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the Medina County Auditor.
- SEC. 3:** That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law.
- SEC. 4:** That this Ordinance shall be considered an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety; wherefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and signature by the Mayor.
