

ORDINANCE NO. 11-20

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 105-19, PASSED JULY 8, 2019 RELATIVE TO BIDDING AND AWARDING A CONTRACT TO THE SUCCESSFUL BIDDER FOR THE SOUTH BROADWAY STREET RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS: Ordinance No. 105-19, passed July 8, 2019, authorized the Mayor to advertise for competitive bids and to award a contract to the successful bidder for the South Broadway Street Reconstruction Project (City Job #992) in the amount of \$1,245,500.00 paid as follows: \$767,500.00 in Account No. 108-0686-54414 and \$478,000.00 in Account No. 380-0686-54414.

WHEREAS: This request is asking for authorization to modify Ordinance 105-19 by increasing the amount authorized to \$1,340,500.00, to include the replacement of all sanitary sewers within the project limits, as requested by the Medina County Sanitary Engineers.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MEDINA, OHIO:

SEC. 1: That the Account Numbers set forth in Sec. 2 of Ordinance 105-19, passed July 8, 2019 is hereby be amended to read as follows: That the estimated cost of the project, in the amount of \$1,340,500.00 is available as follows: \$746,631.00 in Account No. 108-0686-54414, \$478,000.00 in Account No. 380-0686-54414, and \$115,869.00 in Account No. 108-0686-54414 (Medina County).

SEC. 2: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law.

SEC. 3: That this Ordinance shall be considered an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and for the further reason to get the bid process started as soon as possible to begin construction in late winter/early spring; wherefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and signature by the Mayor.
