

**RESOLUTION NO. 179-20**

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND ACCEPTING THE JUSTICE REINVESTMENT INCENTIVE GRANT (JRIG) AWARD FOR THE MEDINA MUNICIPAL COURT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS:** The Medina Municipal Court has been awarded \$143,448.00 through the Justice Reinvestment Incentive Grant (JRIG) to fund electronic monitoring, drug screens and home studies for those defendant's placed on Probation.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MEDINA, OHIO:**

**SEC. 1:** That the Justice Reinvestment Incentive Grant (JRIG) award in the amount of \$143,448.00 is hereby accepted and approved for the Medina Municipal Court.

**SEC. 2:** That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law.

**SEC. 3:** That this Resolution shall be considered an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and for the further reason the grant is effective July 1, 2019 to June 30, 2021; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and signature by the Mayor.
