

ORDINANCE NO. 21-21**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 142-20, PASSED AUGUST 24, 2020, RELATIVE TO THE PAYMENT FOR THE DESIGN-BUILD CONTRACT WITH CPS CONSTRUCTION, INC. FOR DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION OF A CITY HALL PARKING STRUCTURE.**

WHEREAS: Ordinance No. 114-19, passed July 31, 2019, authorized the Design-Build Contract with CPS Construction, Inc. for design and construction of a City Hall Parking Structure; and

WHEREAS: Ordinance No. 142-20, passed August 24, 2020, amended the contract amount from \$3,714,000.00 to \$3,640,571.68 for the design and construction of a City Hall Parking Structure; and

WHEREAS: The City Engineer requests that Ordinance No. 142-20, passed August 24, 2020, be amended to reflect the final payment amount of \$3,744,000.00 which represents an increase in the original contract amount of \$30,000.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MEDINA, OHIO:

SEC. 1: That Section 1 of Ordinance 142-20, passed August 24, 2020 shall be amended to read as follows:

That the contract amount authorized in Ordinance No. 142-20, passed August 24, 2020 is hereby amended from \$3,640,571.68 to \$3,744,000.00 to reflect the final contract amount for the design and Construction of the City Hall Parking Structure.

SEC. 2: That the additional \$30,000.00 in funds to cover these costs are available as follows: \$30,000.00 in Account No. 109-0725.

SEC. 3: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law.

SEC. 4: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect at the earliest period allowed by law.
