PROJECT SCOPE

City of Medina Job No. 1025: West Smith Road Improvements

General

This project consists of the infrastructure improvements on West Smith Road beginning at STA. 67+97 (East of State Road) to STA. 104+46.81 (at South Court Street). Additional work includes, concrete pavement and sidewalk replacement, concrete drive apron replacement, twin elliptical 29" x 45" concrete culvert replacement, 15" sanitary sewer replacement, 12" ductile iron water main installation, storm sewer replacement, street lighting conduit installation, bridge railing installation, and ADA facility upgrades.

- 1. Clearing and grubbing of the existing vegetation as required.
- 2. Sanitary lateral replacement.
- 3. 29"x45" twin elliptical culvert replacement.
- 4. 12" waterline installation.
- 5. Bore and jack operation under the existing railroad crossing.
- 6. Localized sanitary replacement, including manholes as noted in the plans.
- 7. The removal and replacement of the existing storm sewers and storm structures.
- 8. The removal and replacement of existing water services.
- 9. The removal of the concrete pavement, curb, drive aprons, and sidewalk.
- 10. Grading as necessary for the installation of the proposed concrete pavement per the plan cross sections.
- 11. The replacement of the concrete pavement, curb, drive aprons, and sidewalk.
- 12. The removal and re-installation of the existing signal pole at southwest corner of South Court Street.
- 13. Final grading, topsoil placement, and seeding of all areas within the construction limits.

Maintenance of Traffic (Truck Detour and Phased Block Closures):

During construction of the BASE BID, the contractor will be required to close the existing roadway in phases to protect the work zone. Prior to the Pre-Construction Meeting, the Contractor will be required to submit to the City of Medina Engineer's Office a proposed construction schedule. The schedule shall be approved by the City of Medina prior to the start of construction.
