

## 2022 Health Levy Facts

Our mission is to prevent disease, assure a healthful environment, prolong life, and promote well-being for the citizens of Medina County.

- 1. A 10-year renewal of existing .70 mill levy, with the addition of .15 mill
- 2. Cost to home owners will be \$14.70 per year on \$100,000 of valuation (of which \$5.24 is the additional mill)
- The Health Department obtains nonlevy funding for much of its operations, and 69% of expenses are paid from non-levy sources
- 4. This levy was renewed at .70 mill in 2002 and 2012
- Services are provided to residents of all cities, townships, and villages in Medina County
- 6. Your Health Department is **Nationally Accredited**, and this enables us to obtain additional, non-levy funding
