City Income Tax Information

In 2024, the City of Medina initiated a municipal income tax of 1.25%. Through strategic planning, efficiency studies, and a thorough budgeting process, the city has remained fiscally strong during the current economic conditions and this tax has not been raised. City Income Tax must be paid annually to the Regional Income Tax Agency (RITA), located at 10107 Brecksville Road, Brecksville, Ohio. If your employer is not taking this tax out of your pay and sending it to RITA, you are responsible for seeing that it is paid. The date for paying city income tax is the same as State and Federal taxes, April 15, 2025. Beginning in tax year 2024, the income of all individuals under 18 years of age will be exempt from municipal income tax in all municipalities.
