City Gets Ready to Host 31st Annual Elegant Ice Festival

February 14 thru 17 Medina will host the 31st Annual Ice Festival hosted by Elegant Ice Creations. Elegant Ice Creations was founded by Medina native Aaron Costic. Costic is now a world renowned and highly sought after ice carver who has traveled the world creating magnificent ice carvings. He has competed in three Winter Olympics as part of the Cultural Olympiad where he won both a bonze and a gold medal for his sculptures. He also won the World Ice Art Championships in Fairbanks Alaska eight times.

This year's Ice Festival will include over 130 ice sculptures on display throughout the Square and downtown. The schedule will include:

Friday, February 14: Speed Carvings at 5:30 pm, 6 pm, and 6:30 pm

Lighting of Fire and Ice Tower and Fire Dancing at 7 pm

Saturday, February 15: Individual Ice Carving Competitions

Sunday, February 16: Team Ice Carving Competitions

Monday, February 17: Ice carvings on display, if it doesn't get too warm.

Ice carvings are sensitive to the sun and warming temperatures,

so come out early to enjoy them at their best.
