MowGREENER Rebates Offered For Battery Or Electric Mowers

Akron Regional Air Quality Management District, which includes all of Medina County, is offering a rebate program to residents who sign up and switch to electric or battery lawn mowers and other yard-care items. Lawn Care companies are not eligible. You must register for the program,



purchase the new mower, take old gas mower to be recycled at a scrap facility, and turn in receipts for the new mower and scrapping of old gas mower.
