Construction began last May and was built by many volunteers, including the new owner, Medina resident Cathy Howard, who completed hundreds of volunteer hours with Habitat, some of which were at the Habitat ReStore at 233 Lafayette Road in Medina. This is the 54th house built by Habitat in Medina County since 1991.
