## Medina Square Farmers Market Opens May 17

The 2025 Medina Square Farmers Market begins Saturday, May 17, from 9 am-1 pm, at historic Public Square featuring 70+ vendors with the best in locally grown greens, fruits, vegetables, herbs, flowers, heirloom produce, local meats and cheeses, and much more! Treat yourself to homemade jams and jellies, nut butters, local honey, fresh bread and tempting baked goods (GF & V), and pet stuff!

The Medina Square Farmers Market will participate in the Produce Perks Program again this year, which doubles the purchasing power of low-income shoppers – providing a \$1 for \$1 match for families and individuals receiving SNAP (formerly known as food stamps). The match can be used to purchase fruits and vegetables, stretching SNAP dollars for additional healthy foods.

With free parking and easy access, the Medina Square Farmers Market is conveniently located just 4 miles west of I-71. From Cleveland: I-71 South to Rte. 3, turn right and follow into town. From Akron: Route 18 West, just 4 miles past I-71.
