

RESOLUTION NO. 67-18

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE CITY OF MEDINA PARTNERING WITH MONTVILLE TOWNSHIP AND MEDINA TOWNSHIP TO APPLY FOR A GRANT BY THE OHIO AUDITOR OF STATE FOR A SHARED SERVICES FEASIBILITY STUDY TO STUDY THE FEASIBILITY OF ESTABLISHING A JOINT FIRE DISTRICT.

WHEREAS: The City of Medina has been identified by Montville Township as a project partner for a shared services feasibility study; and

WHEREAS: The Auditor of State is authorizing under Ohio Revised Code § 117.473 to conduct shared services feasibility studies at the request of state agencies and local public offices which are performed with the goal of identifying and furthering partner efforts toward more economical, efficient and effective service delivery; and

WHEREAS: If selected, this study will be conducted at no cost to the City, or any of the project partners, and will be paid for using AOS funds; and

WHEREAS: The City of Medina, Montville Township, and Medina Township would like to explore the feasibility of collaborating on a Joint Fire District.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MEDINA, OHIO:

SEC. 1: That Medina City Council supports the City of Medina, Montville Township, and Medina Township to jointly apply for an Auditor of Ohio Grant to study the feasibility of establishing a Joint Fire District in our communities.

SEC. 2: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect at the earliest period allowed by law.
