City Sidewalks Must be Cleared of Snow - Snow Removal Ordinance 902.01

Property owners shall maintain all sidewalks, walkways, stairways, driveways, parking areas, and other similar areas in a proper state of repair, free of hazardous defect and free of hazardous conditions. The owners and occupiers of abutting lots and lands shall keep the sidewalks in repair and free from snow or any nuisance. A separate offense shall be deemed committed each day during which a violation continues or occurs.
