

ORDINANCE NO. 212-25

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A 2026 FREIGHTLINER M2 106 PLUS REAR LOADER GARBAGE TRUCK FROM BEST EQUIPMENT, FOR THE SANITATION DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS: In accordance with ORC 125.04 the City of Medina, Ohio requested authority to participate in State contracts which the Department of Administrative Services has entered into for the purchase of supplies, services, equipment and certain materials; and

WHEREAS: The request for participation provides for the waiving of the state and local competitive bidding requirements and allows the City the ability to purchase from centralized state contracts.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MEDINA, OHIO:

SEC. 1: That the Sanitation Department is hereby authorized to purchase one (1) 2026 Freightliner M2106 plus Cab and Chassis complete with a 25 Cubic Yard Rear Load Leach2 R-111 Body mounted on the chassis, through the Sourcewell Purchasing Contract #110223-LEG.

SEC. 2: That in accordance with Ohio Revised Code §5705.41(D), at the time that the contract or order was made and at the time of execution of the Finance Director’s certificate, sufficient funds were available or in the process of collection, to the credit of a proper fund, properly appropriated and free from any previous encumbrance.

SEC. 3: That the funds to cover this purchase, in the amount of \$284,900.00, are available in Account No. 514-0543-54417.

SEC. 4: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law.

SEC. 5: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect at the earliest period allowed by law.
