

ORDINANCE NO. 40-26

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 31.02 (A) (1) AND 31.02 (A) (2) OF THE SALARIES AND BENEFITS CODE OF THE CITY OF MEDINA, OHIO RELATIVE TO SEASONAL EMPLOYEES FOR THE RECREATION DEPARTMENT AND SERVICE DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS: Section 31.02 (A)(1) and 31.02 (A)(2) of the Salaries and Benefits Code of the City of Medina, Ohio presently reads in part as follows pertaining to Seasonal Employees:

(A) **SEASONAL EMPLOYEES.** (Seasonal positions may not be filled for more than 910 hours or 180 calendar days except those addressed in Teamsters contract)

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MEDINA, OHIO:

SEC. 1: That Section 31.02 (A)(1) and 31.02 (A)(2) of the Salaries and Benefits Code of the City of Medina, Ohio shall be amended to read in part as follows pertaining to Seasonal Employees:
