

**RESOLUTION NO. 46-26**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SUBMIT  
FY27 CONGRESSIONALLY DIRECTED SPENDING  
APPLICATIONS TO SENATOR HUSTED AND  
CONGRESSMAN MAX MILLER’S OFFICES.**

**WHEREAS:** The City of Medina would like to submit FY27 Congressionally Directed Spending (CDS) to Senator Husted and Congressman Max Miller’s offices for the following projects: South Elmwood Parking Lot Renovation, Medina Recreation Center Turf Field House Expansion, and State Road Reconstruction Phase 1 Projects.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY  
OF MEDINA, OHIO:**

**SEC. 1:** That the Mayor is hereby authorized to submit the request for grant funding from the FY27 Congressionally Directed Spending (CDS) applications to Senator Husted and Congressman Max Miller’s offices for the above-mentioned projects.

**SEC. 2:** That if the grant is awarded to the City, the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to accept the grant and enter into an agreement for the implementation and administration of the grant.

**SEC. 3:** That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law.

**SEC. 4:** That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect at the earliest period allowed by law.
