Medina Life Support Team (LST) Celebrates 50 Years of Service

Since April 1976, Medina LST has been providing emergency medical service to the city, later adding Montville Township and Medina Township, and covering approximately 55 square miles. The service is staffed by six certified paramedics on duty 24 hours a day, seven days a week. They respond to more than 4,300 calls each year. Paramedics are experienced professionals with extensive training in emergency medicine, allowing them to assess complex medical conditions, administer medications, and make critical decisions in the field. Each LST ambulance is equipped with state-of-the-art medical and communications equipment. They work closely with Emergency Room physicians at Medina Hospital to ensure continuity of care from the scene to the hospital.

On May 2, you can show your appreciation and help celebrate the LST's 50th anniversary at an Open House from 11:00 am to 200 pm, at Station 4, 1000 East Washington Street (Medina Hospital).
