**Medina Fire Department Hearing-Impaired Smoke Detector Program**

Hearing impaired residents of the City of Medina, Medina Township and Montville Township may apply for a bedside unit linked to existing smoke detectors in the home that will both flash and vibrate under a mattress to wake a sleeping hearing-impaired person and alert them to the emergency. This program is called Project Safe and is free of charge.
