Events take place in and around the Square, unless noted otherwise.

**Beat the Heat in Medina at Memorial Pool or Splashpads**

In addition to the pools at Medina Rec, you can escape that summer heat at Memorial Pool, Medina's outdoor pool, located at 421 East Homestead Street. It is open from 11 am to 7 pm, except Monday and Wednesday when it closes at 5:45 pm because of swim lessons. Admission ranges from \$5 to \$10, and kids under 2 are admitted free. The splash pad at Fred Greenwood Park, 350 West Sturbridge Drive, is open daily from 11 am to 8 pm. Ray Mellert Park Splash pad, at 331 North Huntington Street, is open daily from 12 pm to 8 pm. No admission fee.
