No Better Time to Learn About the History of Medina

As we celebrate our nation's 250 birthday, there is no better time to also learn about Medina's history, and you have three museums to choose from. The City of Medina's Town Hall & Engine House Museum at 50 Public Square is open on Saturday from 9:30 am to 1 pm. Free admission.

The Medina County Historical Society's John Smart House Museum at 206 North Elmwood Avenue, and the McDowell-Phillips House Museum at 205 South Prospect Street, are both open on the second Sunday of the month from 1 pm to 4 pm. A special exhibit of the History of Medicine in Medina County is on view in the Smart House Museum. Fourth graders and children under 7 are admitted free with a paid adult admission.
