2026-27 School Year Begins - Drivers Stay Alert!

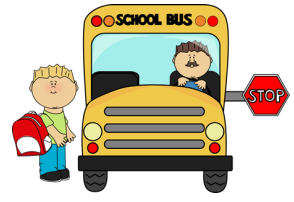
School begins for students living in the City of Medina on: August 18 - Medina County Career Center

In a School Zone:

- Drive at, or below, the posted speed limit, and slow down further when kids are present. Even a 5 mph reduction can significantly lower the risk of a fatal accident.
- Never pass a school bus with the stop-arm extended or red/yellow lights flashing. It's illegal in all 50 states.
- Keep a safe following distance, especially behind buses, to allow time to stop.
- Stay off your phone and pay attention to your surroundings.
