

RESOLUTION NO. 136-26**A RESOLUTION DECLARING MARCH 6, 2027 AS RANDOM ACTS OF KINDNESS DAY IN THE CITY OF MEDINA, OHIO.**

WHEREAS: Kindness is a universal value that fosters stronger, more compassionate communities; and

WHEREAS: Small acts of kindness — whether through words, gestures, or deeds — have the power to uplift individuals, bridge differences, and inspire positive change; and

WHEREAS: Random Acts of Kindness Day encourages people of all ages to intentionally practice kindness in their daily lives; and

WHEREAS: This day serves as a reminder that kindness is not limited to a single day but is a habit that can be cultivated year-round; and

WHEREAS: Promoting kindness aligns with the shared goal of creating a more inclusive, respectful, and supportive society;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MEDINA, OHIO:

SEC. 1: That the City of Medina hereby recognizes March 6, 2027 as Random Acts of Kindness Day and encourages all residents to engage in acts of generosity, empathy, and goodwill toward others.

SEC. 2: Be it further resolved that we commit to fostering a culture where kindness is celebrated, practiced and passed forward, making our community a better place for all.

SEC. 3: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law.

SEC. 4: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect at the earliest period allowed by law.
